Expands Orthopedic Services at Mount St. Mary's Hospital**

Improving access to high quality orthopedic care for residents throughout Niagara County, Mount St. Mary's welcomed three new physicians to its medical staff and announced a new agreement with Excelsior Orthopaedics.

Stephen Watkins, DO, a resident of Lewiston, has joined the hospital's Orthopedic Services team. A graduate of Buffalo State College, Dr. Watkins earned his Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine and Master of Science in Medical Education degrees from Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine in Erie, PA.

Following the opening of Excelsior Orthopaedics' new Niagara Falls office, Mount St. Mary's reached an agreement with the specialty group. As part of the agreement, Excelsior Orthopaedic surgeons Adam Burzynski, MD, and Matthew Mann, MD, will perform surgery at the hospital.

Dr. Burzynski earned his Bachelor's Degree from SUNY Buffalo and his Medical Degree from Upstate Medical University in Syracuse. Specializing in orthopedics and sports medicine, he completed an orthopedic surgical residency at the University of Cincinnati Medical Center and a sports medicine fellowship at the University at Buffalo, where he served as an Assistant Team Physician for the Buffalo Bills and Buffalo Sabres.
