

Catholic Health has earned Level 7 Recognition for its acute care, ambulatory and long-term care services in the College of Healthcare Information Management Executives' (CHIME) 2021 Digital Health Most Wired Survey. Catholic Health is the only healthcare organization in Western New York to earn these certifications.



For its certification program, CHIME conducts annual surveys to assess how effectively healthcare organizations apply core and advanced technologies in their clinical and business practices to improve healthcare in their communities.
